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Highlights

1. Supporting employees and employers affected by the COVID-19 pandemic

On 01/10/2021, the Government has enacted Decision No.28/2021/QĐ-TTg on implementation of policies to support employees and employers affected by the COVID-19 pandemic from the Unemployment Insurance Fund (“Decision 28”).

Accordingly, financial aid is given to the followings:

- (a) Employees participating in Unemployment Insurance till 30 September 2021;
(Except those working for the state agencies, political organizations, socio-political organizations, units of people’s armed forces and public service units whose recurrent expenditures are financed by the state budget).
- (b) Employees whose employment contracts have already been terminated within the period from 1 January 2020 to end of 30 September 2021, and whose UI contribution periods are reserved (except those receiving monthly pension).

Lump sum aid amounts varying according to the UI contribution period for which unemployment benefits are not received will be calculated as follows:

- (a) UI contribution period of less than 12 months: 1,800,000 dong/person.
- (b) UI contribution period between 12 months and less than 60 months: 2,100,000 dong/person.
- (c) UI contribution period between 60 months and less than 84 months: 2,400,000 dong/person.
- (d) UI contribution period between 84 months and less than 108 months: 2,650,000 dong/person.
- (e) UI contribution period between 108 months and less than 132 months: 2,900,000 dong/person.
- (f) UI contribution period of at least 132 months: 3,300,000 dong/person.

Financial aid is commencing on 1 October 2021 and completed by 31 December 2021 at the latest.

The implementation of support policies for employees participating in social insurance (social insurance) affected by the COVID-19 pandemic is carried out as follows:

- (a) The social insurance agency compiles a list of employees eligible for support and sends it to the employer for the employee to confirm the information on the support.

No later than 20 October 2021, the social insurance agency must complete the list to all employers and make publicly available the information of those eligible for support on the agency's website of Provincial social insurance.

- (b) Within 5 days from the date of receiving the list sent by the social insurance agency, the employer reviews the list sent by the insurance agency. Then, the employer amends and completes the list along with the dossier as prescribed and send it to the social insurance agency.
- (c) Within 10 working days from date of receiving the correct and complete list of employees, and within 20 days from date of receiving the corrected list sent by the employer, the agency Social insurance agency pays the financial assistance to employees...

For employees who have stopped paying unemployment insurance, the following procedures shall be followed:

- (a) Employees request the social insurance agency of the province/district where they want to receive the financial assistance using Form No. 04, no later than 20 December 2021.
- (b) The social insurance agency pays the financial assistance within 10 days from the date of receiving the request, the payment must be completed no later than 20 December 2021.

2. Instructions for testing SARS-CoV-2 virus at production and business facilities

On 30 September 2021, the Ministry of Health issued Official Dispatch No.8228/BYT-MT, providing guidelines for testing SARS-CoV-2 virus at production and business facilities.

Accordingly, the Ministry of Health requests ministries and central authorities and the provincial-level People’s Committees to implement the regulations on testing for SARS-CoV-2 at production and business facilities (businesses) as follows:

- (a) Performing screening tests for all employees showing signs or symptoms of COVID-19 such as cough, fever, shortness of breath, etc. or relevant epidemiological factors.
- (b) Perform periodic tests for employees:

Note:

** Do not test fully vaccinated people (those who have received their last dose at least 14 days before and within 12 months), or people who have fully recovered from COVID-19 in the past 6 months (the test is recommended and optional, not compulsory).*

- (c) RT-PCR tests or rapid antigen tests are used.
- (d) The test results shall be promptly reported to the medical centre of district where the business is located.

(within 2 hours after the end of the testing date and immediately reported if there is any case tested positive for SARS- CoV-2).

If businesses perform rapid antigen tests for SARS-COV-2 virus on their own, they shall follow the guidelines of provincial-level Centres for Disease Control (CDC) or medical centres of districts. The rapid antigen test kits for SARS-COV-2 shall be those on the list of tests issued with registration numbers or import licenses of the Ministry of Health. The businesses shall be liable for the quality of rapid antigen tests, respective procedures, and results. The medical centres shall inspect, supervise the implementation, and take actions in a timely manner and in accordance with the regulations on receiving any test results of positive for SARS-CoV-2 virus.

Drivers of vehicles transporting goods between provinces and cities: If the driver travels from an area where the social distancing has been imposed under Directive No. 16/CT-TTg to a neighbouring area where a lower COVID-19 risk level has applied, the testing shall be performed by the health facilities; the testing time shall comply with Official Dispatch No. 5753/BYT-MT dated 19 July 2021 on testing and facilitating transporters of goods.

3. Amendment of Decree on E-Commerce

Within the last two years, Vietnam’s E-Commerce market (“E-Commerce”) has been and is currently developing rapidly and becoming increasingly vibrant due to the impact of Covid-19 pandemic. Meanwhile, the legal instruments regulating this activity – Decree No. 52/2013/ND-CP, dated 16/05/2013, on E-Commerce; as amended and supplemented by Decree No.

08/2018/ND-CP dated 15 January 2018, amending a number of Decrees related to business investment conditions under the scope of the State management of the Ministry of Industry and Trade (“**Decree 52**”) – has already been enacted since 2013 and is in need of updates accordingly to the current development status. As a result, on 25 September 2021, the Government has recently enacted Decree No. 85/2021/ND-CP, amending articles of Decree 52 (“**Decree 85**”) with several following notable updates.

Additional subjects participating in E-commerce activities

Pursuant to Decree 85, traders and organizations providing logistics services are officially recognized as subjects of E-Commerce activities. Specifically, Article 1.6 of Decree 85 amending Clause 5, Article 24 of Decree 52 stipulates:

“Article 24. Subjects of E-Commerce activities

5. Traders and organizations providing technical infrastructure, logistics services and other support services for E-Commerce activities.”

Social networks can also be considered as E-Commerce websites

In parallel with goods trading activities on specialized E-COMMERCE sites such as Shopee.vn, Tiki.vn, Lazada.vn, etc., online sales activities on social networking sites such as Facebook, Zalo, Instagram, etc. are also vigorous. Since the effective date of Decree 85 (*i.e.*, 1 January 2022), these social networking sites will also be considered as E-Commerce trading platform if falling into the cases prescribed by the law. Specifically, Article 1.15 of Decree 85/2021 amending Clause 2, Article 35 of Decree 52 stipulates:

“2. Operational forms of E-Commerce trading platform:

- a) Websites allow participants to open virtual stores to display and introduce goods or services;*
- b) Websites allow participants to open accounts to perform the contract signing process with customers;*
- c) The website has a buying and selling section, which allows participants to post information about buying and selling goods and services;*
- d) Social networks have one of the forms of activities specified at Points a, b and c of this Clause and participants directly or indirectly pay fees for the performance of such activities..”*

Provisions on E-Commerce activities of foreign traders and organizations

In addition to amendments to the existing regulations, Decree 85 also added completely new regulations for E-Commerce activities of foreign traders and organizations. Specifically, the new Decree expands the scope of application to apply to websites providing E-Commerce services in Vietnam to include websites of foreign traders and organizations with the following forms of operation:

- (a) E-commerce websites with Vietnam domain name (i.e. “.vn”);*
- (b) E-commerce websites with Vietnamese as display language; and*

- (c) *E-commerce websites with over 100,000 transactions in Vietnam a year.*

Thus, E-Commerce websites of foreign traders and organizations such as Amazon, Ebay, Taobao are also likely to be considered as those providing E-Commerce services in Vietnam and must comply with the regulations on E-Commerce under Vietnamese law (including (i) registration of E-Commerce activities; and (ii) establishment of a representative office in Vietnam; or (iii) appointment of an authorized representative in Vietnam).

Provisions on information of goods and services

Decree 85 has added the specific requirements on the information of goods and services that need to be published on the E-Commerce website. Specifically, information on goods published on the website must include: *“compulsory contents shown on goods labels as prescribed by the law on goods labelling, except for product-specific information such as: year, month, date of manufacture; expiry date; production batch number; identification number of machines.”*

Moreover, sellers of goods and suppliers of services must also meet investment and business conditions applicable to conditional business lines. On top of that, these sellers and suppliers are also required to *“publish the number, date and place of issue of the License, Certificate of satisfaction of conditions, written certification, or other forms of documents as prescribed by the law on business conditions for that line of business”*.

4. New regulations on invoices and accounting records

On 17 September 2021, the Ministry of Finance has issued Circular No. 78/2021/TT-BTC, providing guidelines for implementation of some articles of the Law on Tax Administration, Decree No.123/2020/ND-CP regulating on invoices, accounting records (“Circular 78”).

In particular, the new Circular regulates several contents regarding electronic invoice including:

- Authorization for e-invoicing;
- Templates for displaying electronic invoices;
- Symbols of e-invoice number, e-invoice symbols;
- Convert to apply e-invoices with code of tax authorities;
- Apply e-invoice for some other cases;
- An electronic invoice with a tax authority's code is generated from a cash register with an electronic data transfer connection with the tax authorities;
- Criteria for selecting an organization providing services on e-invoices to sign a contract to provide e-invoice services with the tax authority's

code and services of receiving, transmitting, and storing invoice data and other related services.

Besides, Circular 78 also stipulates several contents on paper invoices such as: Name of invoice type, symbol for invoice number model, invoice symbol, name of invoice printed by the Tax Department, symbol for invoice number model that is stamp, ticket, and card ordered for printing by the Tax Department, etc.

This Circular will take effect on 1 July 2022.
