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Highlights

1. Overtime increased from 200 hours to 300 hours per year

On 23 March 2022, the Standing Committee of the National Assembly approved Resolution No. 17/2022/UBTVQH15, on the annual and monthly overtime hours of employees while ensuring COVID-19 prevention and control and socio-economic recovery and development.

According to the new Resolution, an employer may have employees to work overtime for 200-300 hours per year if it is so agreed by the employees, except for the following cases:

- (a) Employees aged between full 15 and under 18;
- (b) Employees with mild disabilities with work capacity reduction of at least 51% or employees with severe disabilities or extremely severe disabilities;
- (c) Employees doing arduous, hazardous, dangerous or extremely arduous, hazardous or dangerous works;
- (d) Female employees in their 7th month of pregnancy onward (or in the 6th month of pregnancy onward in case they work in the highlands, remote areas, bordering areas or islands);
- (e) Female employees nursing children under 12 months of age.

The above-mentioned provisions came into force from 1 January 2022 and do not apply to the cases specified in Clause 3, Article 107 of the Labour Code.

This Resolution shall take effect on 1 April 2022.

2. Applications for self-declaration of personal income tax (PIT) from tax year 2021

On 24 March 2022, the General Department of Taxation has issued Official Dispatch No. 883/TCT-DNNCN, providing guidelines for PIT declaration.

According to this Official Dispatch, taxpayer may directly submit to the tax authority a tax declaration including:

- (a) PIT declaration form made according to Form No. 02/QTT-TNCN accompanying Circular No. 80/2021/TT-BTC dated 9 September 2021 (“**Circular 80**”).
- (b) A list of dependent reduction according to Form No.02-1/BK-QTT-TNCN accompanying Circular 80.
- (c) Copies of original documents showing the amount of tax deducted or provisionally paid in the year or paid overseas (if any).

If the income-paying organization does not provide tax deduction documents for the taxpayer because it has been closed down, the tax authority shall, according to the taxation database, consider processing the taxpayer's dossier without requiring the tax deduction documents.

In the case where the income-paying organization or individual (employer) uses electronic PIT deduction documents, the taxpayer shall print and use physical copies of the electronic PIT deduction documents sent to the taxpayer by the employer.

- (d) A copy of the tax deduction certificate (clearly stating the income tax declaration under which the tax payment has been made) issued by the employer (or copies of the bank documents on the overseas tax payment with certification of the taxpayer in the case where the foreign authority does not issue a written certificate for tax payment according to the laws of that country).
- (e) Copies of invoices and other supporting documents proving contributions to charitable funds, humanitarian funds or scholarship funds (if any).
- (f) Documents proving the amount of money already paid by the overseas income-paying organization if the taxpayer's income was paid from abroad by Embassy, Consulate or international organization.
- (g) Dependent registration dossier according to the guidelines (in the case where dependent exemption is claimed at the time of tax declaration for unregistered dependents).

3. Rent support for employees in industrial zones (IZs) and export processing zones (EPZs)

On 28 March 2022, the Prime Minister has promulgated Decision No.08/2022/QĐ-TTg, on implementation of policies on rent support for employees.

To be specific, an employee who is working for an enterprise in an IZ or EPZ or a key economic zone (KEZ) will be eligible for support if he/she fully satisfies the following conditions:

- (a) He/she rents an accommodation from 1 February 2022 to 30 June 2022.
- (b) He/she has an indefinite-term employment contract or a definite-term employment contract with a duration of at least 1 month, which was concluded and executed prior to 1 April 2022.
- (c) He/she is participating in compulsory social insurance (SI) (included in the list of participants in compulsory SI of social insurance agency) in the month preceding the month in which the enterprise makes the list of employees applying for rent support.

In the case where the employee does not participate in compulsory SI as specified in Article 2.4 of Decree No. 115/2015/ND-CP, he/she must be included in the enterprise's payroll of the month preceding the month in which the enterprise makes the list of employees applying for rent support.

Employees who are working in enterprises meeting all the above-mentioned conditions will receive a monthly support of 500.000 VND/person/month given by the State during a supporting period of up to 3 months.

This Decision shall take effect on 28 March 2022.

4. Amended regulations on importing films for non-commercial purposes

On 25 March 2022, the Government has issued Decree No. 22/2022/ND-CP amending Decree No. 32/2012/ND-CP, on management of the export and import of cultural products for non-commercial purposes (“Decree 22”).

Accordingly, the new Decree adds a number of regulations on the import of cultural products (films, etc.) for non-commercial purposes, for example:

- (a) The film import licensing agency revokes the Film import license when it detects that the content of the film violates the prohibition provisions of the Law on Cinematography.
- (b) Individuals who import films only for personal use undertake not to violate the prohibition provisions of the Law on Cinematography and uses the films in accordance with the provisions of the laws.
- (c) For cultural products being films: The time for film assessment shall not exceed 12 working days from the date on which the organization provides the film copy.

In addition, Decree 22 amends definition of cultural products, including:

- (a) Sound and video recordings; film types; other audio-visual technology products recorded on digital materials or media in text, audio or visual forms.

Audio or video recordings with content that substitutes for books or illustrates books and electronic publications specified in the Law on Publication are not included. (This is a new provision)
- (b) Visual, applied arts, painting, photographic works.
- (c) Tangible cultural heritage and related products of intangible cultural heritage.

This Decree shall take effect on 10 May 2022.

5. Contents of petition for application of transitional RCEP safeguard measures

On 23 March 2022, the Minister of Industry and Trade promulgated Circular No. 07/2022/TT-BCT, providing guidelines for implementation of trade remedies in the Regional Comprehensive Economic Partnership (RCEP) Agreement.

According to the new Circular, a petition for application of transitional RCEP safeguard measures shall contain:

- (a) Name, address and necessary information of the organization or individual which is a representative of domestic production industry,
- (b) Information, data, and evidence for determining a representative for domestic production industry, etc.
- (c) Names and addresses of producers of similar goods which support or oppose the case;
- (d) Information describing imports which are eligible for special preferential import tariff according to RCEP Agreement, subject to investigation for application of transitional RCEP safeguard measures, etc.
- (e) Information describing similar goods or directly competitive goods of the domestic production industry, etc.
- (f) Information about the volume, quantity, and value of goods within 3 years before submission of the case dossier and at least 6 months after the RCEP Agreement comes into force, etc.
- (g) Specific requirements for application of the transitional RCEP safeguard measures, duration, and level of application.

This Circular shall take effect on 8 May 2022.

6. Guidance on timing of invoice issuance for entitlement to VAT rate reduction to 8%

On 23 March 2022, the Ministry of Finance issues the Official Dispatch No.2688/BTC-TCT, regarding Value-Added Tax (VAT) prescribed in the Government's Decree No. 15/2022/ND-CP.

According to this Official Dispatch, the Ministry of Finance provides guidance on timing of invoice issuance for entitlement to the policy on VAT rate reduction from 10% to 8% as follows:

- (a) If business entities signing contracts for provision of chargeable services have invoiced these services at the time of collection of service charges at 10% rate before 1 February 2022, and their provision of these services is completed during the period from 1 February 2022 to end of 31 December 2022:
 - (i) The amount recorded in the invoice issued before 1 February 2022 will not be eligible for this VAT rate reduction policy.

- (ii) The remaining amount recorded in the invoice issued within the period from 1 February 2022 to end of 31 December 2022 will be eligible.
- (b) If business entities subject to 10% VAT in January 2022 do not issue their invoices until February 2022, they will be considered mistiming for invoice issuance; thus, not entitled to the VAT rate reduction.
- (c) For any invoice issued before 1 February 2022 at 10% rate, if there is any error found in the invoice after 1 February 2022, the new invoice correcting this error and the invoice for goods return will be issued at the VAT rate of 10%.
- (d) For provision of special goods and services like electricity, business entities will be entitled to VAT reduction as per the laws and regulations if invoices are issued within the period from 1 February 2022 to end of 31 December 2022.

7. Additional regulations for preferential import and export tariff under the CPTPP Agreement

On 10 March 2022, the Government has promulgated Decree No.21/2022/ND-CP (“Decree 21”), replacing Decree No. 57/2019/ND-CP, on Preferential import and export tariff and Special preferential import tariff under the Comprehensive and Progressive Agreement for Trans-Pacific Partnership (CPTPP Agreement) in the 2019-2022 period (“Decree 57”).

The CPTPP Agreement officially came into force in the Republic of Peru from 19 September 2021. Therefore, Decree 21 on additional regulations applicable to Peru is promulgated for implementation of the CPTPP Agreement in the 2019-2022 period. In particular:

- (a) Additional regulations on preferential export duty rates and special preferential import duty rates applicable to goods exported from Vietnam to Peru and vice versa.
- (b) Additional conditions for applying preferential export duty rates and special preferential import duty rates to goods exported from Vietnam to Peru and vice versa.

For customs declarations of Vietnam’s imports and exports from/to Peru that have been registered from 19 September 2021 to before 10 March 10, 2022: If the conditions for applying preferential export tariff or special preferential import tariff prescribed in Decree 57 and Decree 21 have been fully satisfied and the taxpayer has paid tax at a higher rate, the customs authority shall settle the overpaid tax amount in accordance with the laws on tax administration.

Decree 21 shall take effect on 10 March 2022.

8. Construction contractors' obligation to purchase compulsory third-party liability insurance

This is one of notable contents of Decree No. 20/2022/ND-CP dated 10 March 2022 (“Decree 20”), amending Decree No. 119/2015/ND-CP dated 13 November 2015, on compulsory construction insurance.

The new Decree stipulates that, as from 1 July 2022, construction contractors are obliged to purchase compulsory insurance covering workers who work at construction sites and compulsory third-party liability insurance.

Also, it provides additional regulations on compulsory third-party liability insurance, for example:

- (a) Insurance premiums are included into production and business costs;
- (b) Insurance term is a specific period from the start date to the end date of the construction period specified in the construction contract and the insurance contract;
- (c) The minimum coverage for protection against damage to health and life is one hundred million Vietnamese Dong (VND 100,000,000) per a person involved in a case without limiting the number of occurrences; etc.

Compulsory construction insurance contracts and third-party liability insurance contracts already executed prior to 1 July 2022 will remain valid according to the provisions of laws in force at the time of such contracts.

Amendments or supplements to the insurance contract which have not been made in accordance with Decree 20 will be so in accordance with this Decree.

This Decree shall take effect on 1 July 2022.
